The Foundation conducts research into the advantages and disadvantages of proven redistricting methods, generates nonpartisan analysis of the issues, and makes the results of both available to the public for educational purposes.

As we know, a gerrymandering amendment is (was) on the November 3 ballot this year. At the time of this newsletter, no results were known. AAUW has endorsed efforts to end gerrymandering. Come and learn what Virginia has done and what our next steps are.

The following is a statement from AAUW CEO KIMBERLY CHURCHES

AAUW joins the country in mourning the losses of George Floyd, Ahmaud Arbery, Breonna Taylor and countless other people of color who have been unjustly killed across our nation. Our country needs healing. But healing will only come with justice. As an organization we condemn racism.

Systemic racism is firmly rooted in the U.S. and today's injustices mirror our shameful history — from police brutality to the disproportionate impact of COVID-19 on communities of color. There can be no justice or equality when Black and Brown communities are seen as less deserving of basic human and civil rights.

On behalf of our 170,000 members and supporters, we commit to fighting for justice, long-term and lasting change, and we stand in solidarity against racism. We also acknowledge that as an organization we have our own work to do. ZOOM INSTRUCTIONS FOR PARTICIPANTS

Before a videoconference:

1. You will need a tablet, smartphone, or computer that has a microphone and headphones. You will have the opportunity to check your audio immediately upon joining a meeting.

2. You will receive a link to the conference call. The notification will include a link to "Join via computer" It will also include the 10-digit (usually) Meeting ID.

To join the videoconference:

1. At the start time of your meeting, click on the link in your invitation to join via computer. You may be instructed to download the Zoom application.

2. You have an opportunity to test your audio at this point by clicking on "Test Computer Audio." Once you are satisfied that your audio works, click on "Join audio by computer."

You may also join a meeting without clicking on the invitation link by going to join.zoom.us on any browser and entering the Meeting ID provided.


Adelante Book Club
